

with the dances. "That's how we learnt - through practice, sharing and swapping dances. Yvonne and Dyker Holland from County Durham, and Alan and Anne Mathieson from Rosyth are two couples who really helped us

Doreen and Shuggie first got to grips with a class of their own when the local Mormon Church asked how they too might enjoy the fun. No doubt another eventful story because the Bear Essentials were born. Now they meet five days of the week, hold regular workshops and party socials, making them one of the liveliest dance clubs in the east of Scotland.

It's not quite jungle training but Shuggie can more than cope with line dance new recruits, and it's not quite so wearing on the dicky ticker. There's no restriction on uniform, and he can grow his beard as long as he likes. Doreen for her part can enjoy her first love, country music (er, better make that second), and also enjoys teaching. In the day she works as a nursery

nurse so she's well used to handling







LINE dancing and country music are natural partners so when you're planning a line dancing holiday in the States you'll think first of Nashville, the home of country music. Well they may have the most famous western dance hall - 'The Wild Horse Saloon' but there are other areas of the country where line dancing has a bigger following and this year's holiday is based on one of them - the east coast from New Jersey to Florida.

We're starting off in Washington but only there long enough to collect the luggage (1 case on the way in -but who knows how many on the way back - clothing and especially western wear is so much cheaper in the U.S.) and a car because our first weekend is being spent in Norfolk, Virginia some 200 miles south of Washington. Norfolk is situated at the mouth of Chesapeake Bay and its home to over 100 ships of the U.S. Atlantic Fleet, so it'll be line dancing with a nautical flavour - lots of sailor shuffles!!

From Norfolk we're heading across the bay into Maryland heading for Philadelphia and Atlantic City. The guidebooks say Atlantic City has quite a lively night scene and we've quite a choice already for line dance venues. No more than a couple of nights here though, we've still 1800 miles to Orlando. Then we've a small detour to make to visit the Pennsylvania Dutch Country, the area where the Amish Brethren Live (remember Harrison Ford and 'Witness').

As well as museums and monuments (and the 'odd' politician) Washington has a lively dance scene and our way back to the south takes us there again before we get onto the coastal roads that will take us all the way to Orlando through North and South Carolina. Ever heard of Myrtle Beach? I never had but its home to some famous golf courses (not my game) and is one of the main coastal holiday resorts. Its got a feast of line dancing venues and more

than its fair share of shopping malls probably need to buy a suitcase here!


Its then on to more familiar sounding places - Savannah and Charleston and on the way passing through Beaufort ('Forrest Gump' was filmed here). Except for the general direction we're travelling, we've no fixed plan, it's more 'walkabout' than a route march and whilst we have a list of instructors in all the areas we're passing through, we're really looking for the surprises - the 'gems' off the beaten track which haven't yet been totally invaded by the tourist.

Of course we're ending the holiday at Disneyland. Its a good area for line dancing as well as all the other attractions.

The customary Welsh curtain of rain and cloudy skies greeted me as I passed the Croeso i Gymru sign ('Welcome to Wales' for those who don't know) on the A55 but, as if on cue, the sun burst through the clouds as I pulled up and dismounted outside one of Liandudno's newest attractions, the Honky-Tonk-Bar Association "Dance Ranch" Western Line Dancing Club.

The HTBA was founded over four years ago by husband and wife team Mike and Sheila Parkinson, qualified British Western Dance Association instructors. The club situated in Vaughan Street in the centre of Llandudno opened in January 1997 and has everything a dancer could hope for. What was once the town's old British Legion concert room, is now the scene of thigh slappin' hot stompin' hand clappin' western dancin'. After a careful refurbishment there is now a raised stage directly in front of a 1500 square foot dance floor so everyone gets a clear view of the instructor and an excellent PA system ensures everyone can hear the instructions clearly. A really nice touch I noticed was a poster showing guidelines for dance floor etiquette which Sheila and Mike had proudly displayed near the entrance. The Club has an unlicensed bar, serving soft drinks and beverages, a kitchen with hot and cold food on special dance nights and a small retail outlet run by Dorothy "Dotty"

Crossland, which carries a range of C&W clothes and accessories.

I was met by Sheila, an attractive 5' 6" brunette, with a warm smile and friendly greeting, she immediately took me under her wing. Michael, all six feet of him,



cut a dashing figure on the stage where he was busy teaching the afternoon "Tea Dance" class Doug Laing's "Badly Bent". Afternoon classes are especially for the active retired and generally attended by about 25-30 people of all ages. The youngest dancer was 35, the oldest, Sheila Hollis, who has only been dancing seven weeks, is a mere 62. Mike later told me that the oldest dancer they teach is 78! The Evening classes (8.30pm-11pm), are for mixed ability dancers and cater for the beginner through to the advanced dancer. The "Dance Ranch" has gone from strength to strength since it began with just one class and 5 students! Nowadays the HTBA holds ten classes a week, afternoons and evenings, has 350 club members and is visited by enthusiasts from as far afield as Durham, Bolton and Wigan. No doubt this is due to the

boundless enthusiasm of Mike and Sheila and that lovely Welsh welcome they keep there. Mike and Sheila are conscientious instructors running a happy and lively club. It is clear they are dedicated dancers who work hard to give everyone a great time. As Mike said, "We are a dance club rather than a Western club. Strictly for the dancers. That's why we call it a Dance Ranch". This



emphasis on the dancers is something Mike stressed throughout the day and is certainly supported by the style, level of difficulty and variety of dances they teach at the club - making sure there's something for everyone.

In addition to Badly Bent they taught, reviewed or danced Las Vegas Strut, Watermelon Crawl, Fuzzy Duck Slide, Hillbilly Rock, Cotton Eyed Joe, Alpine, Saloon Scissors Stomp and High Test Love.

No doubt about it - the Honky-Tonk-Bar Association Dance Ranch is a godsend to C&W dancers looking for both a serious dance venue and expert tuition. I would certainly commend it to all Linedancer readers. Mike and Sheila were wonderful hosts. Beware of having a great time!!

The Bellamy Brothers are to make a long awaited tour of the UK in May. Appearing at two venues; the Centrum Arena in Prestwick. Ayrshire on Saturday 3rd May and the Shepherds Bush Arena, London on Sunday 4th May where they will be supported by the Dean Brothers. It has been a decade since their last appearance in England and their first ever performance in Scotland, book now to avoid disappointment

Howard and David Bellamy were born in Darby, Florida and grew up on cattle ranch which has been owned by the Bellamy family since the U.S. Civil War. At the age of 17 David wrote the song "Spiders and Snakes" for Jim Stafford which subsequently sold over 3 million copies. Their first hit as a duo, "Let your Love Flow", topped the US charts in 1976 but it was three years before they had another hit single. In 1979, "If I Said You Had a Beautiful Body Would You Hold It Against Me", (nominated for a Grammy) shot to number one in the US charts and stayed there for three weeks.

This was followed by 11 more number one hits including, "You'll Never be Sorry", which held the number one spot for twenty seven weeks.

The duo are extremely popular with Line Dancers in the USA and a number of dances

have been choreographed especially for their songs. The most well known dances being "Reagae Cowboy", "Big Hair" by Gloria Johnson to the track "Big Hair" and :"Lightning Cha Cha" by Gloria Johnson to the track "We Dared the Lightning".

I was fortunate enough to speak with Howard in America before his visit and asked him a few questions on behalf of our readers:

Q: "What do you think about New Country?"

A: "There's so little of it that turns me on. I see a lot of the creativity and character in the acts disappearing... LeAnn Rimes is the exception. She could sing as soon as she was

Q: "What do you think about Line Dancing?"

A: "We saw it taking root in the 70's and 80's and we love to see people dancing during the show. If people don't get up and dance at our shows we think we're doing something wrong!... We owe a lot to dance. It helped us launch our own record label."

Q: "What is your favourite album?"

A: "Sons of Beaches. I feel pretty good about it. I see ourselves learning and progressing.

Q: "I know you were influenced by the Beatles and Brewer & Shipley but were you influenced by any other artists?"


A: "The 60's era of music was one of the most creative. Joni Mitchell, Van Morrison and Merle Haggard are some of our all time favourites."






It must be difficult for any band to compete in the current frenzied country music market, in an atmosphere which is highly charged, super critical and in which only the best will survive! It's therefore interesting to listen to a band which has torsaken the cover version route of tried and trusted songs, in favour of an album of original material.

Because I'm from the "I know what I like" school I thought it safer to ask a colleague to listen to the album as well. This is a music review by majority vote! Quite fitting for election time!

Well then, what did we make of it? I found the first track 'Hot Dog' a curious mix of styles. It has a swing feel which I normaly like, but on this occasion ! couldn't get into it. The next track 'And Then Some' a Cha Cha, is O.K. but still didn't hit the mark. The title track "River Road' didn't particularly appeal either. Then, track four, "Silver Shadow" and BINGO! This is the type of stuff I like. This music had character. This was the one I would be playing very loud on the drive to work and the tune that would be with me for the rest of the day. Good Stuff. From there on I found the CD very enjoyable. The lead vocals from Steve Jay were good and strong, and the steel guitar played by Geoff Eatwell was just my cup of tea.

How did my colleague view things? Well, rather differently. For a start, he liked the first track enough to think it one of the best on the album mainly because it was one of the more danceable tracks. Most of the tracks are dancer friendly with long introductions allowing time to find a spot on the dance floor and decide what to dance. Rhythms are varied but the faster tracks are best.

The CD cover contains dances for each song choreographed by members of the Silver Shadow Western Dance Club and a list of popular dances suitable for each track. With beats per minute, track timing and a section on dance floor etiquette these guys give you every opportunity to dance to their music.





How times have changed!

Our then-and-now photos show dancing at the Floral Hall about 40 years ago when ladies graced the floor in full-length dresses and men wore black-ties and evening suits, in stark contrast to the jeans, check shirts, boots, bolo ties and Stetsons which are the order for today's dancers (skirts are o.k. too... but only if you're a lady!).

Dancers once held each other in their arms and danced around the floor in circles, now dancers hardly every touch except perhaps when they accidently bump into each other. And as we always say in line dancin' "you can bump into the nicest of people!"

Last month Linedancer Magazine hosted a performance by America's queen of line dance, Scooter Lee at the Floral Hall which, as the photographs show, has recently been restored to its former glory costing a cool £2.5 million todate. It is clear somebody thinks there's a commercial future in large dance floors.

Camera crews from Granada Television were there making a programme about line dancing. They interviewed Scooter and kept cameras rolling throughout the evening. The producer and crew appeared totally bemused by the frienzied activity of dancers running onto the floor whenever they heard the introductions to their favourite dances. It is good to see line dancing getting this kind of TV interest. Although the venue was the same, the music and dances have changed dramatically. The graceful partner dances of the past have given way to exciting routines performed solo to every rhythm and tempo imaginable. The atmosphere is completely relaxed, very lively and uninhibited.

Now, a dancer, male or female simply steps onto the dance floor at will. No more wallflowers waiting to be invited, no staying at home because you don't have a partner, no embarrassing rejections... and none of those complicated feather steps, heel turns or impetus pulls to be seen. Instead dancers enjoy the freedom to move in their own way with vines, stomps, hitches scoots, hooks and all sorts of happy-golucky steps (Happy because they're such great fun to do and lucky because most of them are very easy).

In the current picture line dancers are giving some stick to Louisiana Hot Sauce, a favourite floor filler, with Scooter Lee on stage singing her hit for the dance 'He's My Little Jalapeno'. The popular lady fills dance floors today as easily as the big bands did 40 years ago. Her

unusual and powerful voice reaches to the heart and toes of line dancers who can't resist the instinct to get up and dance. Scooter makes no bones about composing and performing especially to please her dancers. And the dancers made no bones about loving every beat of it.

Often described as 'a country Bette Midler' she delivers a humourous routine poking fun at her size, her broken marriage and her background, then she delivers dance track favourites like Honky Tonk Twist, Merry-go-round, Rompin' Stompin' Shadows in the Night and Rock and Roll Waltz keeping the dance floor packed all night. Always hungry for new routines, the dancers were delighted when Rob Fowler, the current European Dance Champion and one the UK's most successful choreographers and instructors, took the stage to teach one of his own dances 'Haych Haych' which went down a bomb to Scooter's 'Honey Hush'. Later, Rob taught another dance choreographed by Robert Royston (Dublin, California) called Rompin' Stompin' this natually goes to the track of the same name on Scooter's High Test Love album.

Although working to a hectic schedule Scooter stayed behind after the show to sign autographs and pose with fans for photographs. There's so much more to this lady than we can do justice to in this article but watch for Scooter's

Swim in circles?

"How would you like to go to Nashville to cut an album?"
The voice of Lee Williams from Country Music
Radio was serious as he posed the
question. Lee had taken an interest in
the singer/song writer and
identified a unique talent.
Listening on the other end of the
phone Sam Millar couldn't
believe his ears.

"Do one legged ducks swim in circles?" he replied and so the fairy story begins.

Once upon a time there was a handsome young man who loved to sing. His name was Sam Millar. Sam lived in Hackney, London where he was born into an Irish family. When he was seven he joined his father and two uncles as they sang their way around the pubs of London town. Sam's bright eyes would shine with delight as they sang the old Irish songs and popular tunes of the day,

but never quite as brightly as when they sang the country songs which were Sam's favourites.

Many years later Sam sent a demo tape to Country Music Radio...... they liked it so much they waved a magic wand and soon Sam found himself on a fairly tale trip to Nashville to make is debut album. Interviewing Sam was like listening to a man who lived through such a fairy tale. Still in a state of high excitement, like a child at Christmas Sam hardly stopped to draw a breath as he told me: "I was in Nashville for 10 days and I cried for 6 of them."

In a tempo equalling 'Ain't goin' down till the sun comes up' he gushed, "I couldn't believe it, I just didn't believe I was going until my bum was on the seat of the plane. Then, when we were met at the airport by a stretched limo with Bill Linn inside, you know, the drummer for Elvis, I just started filling up".

Sam doesn't wait for my reaction, but starts off again, "When we got to the studio, would you believe it, the producer of my album was Mark Moseley, you know, the guy who produces some of the biggest acts - I mean people like Garth Brooks and Vince Gill" "Oh and guess what? (No pause for a guess) while I was in the studio, I brushed passed Garth Brooks on his way out, he'd been

ushed passed Garth Brooks on his way out, he'd been showing photographs of his kids to someone there."

Sam's on a roll, the words flow faster than ever: "The next thing I know, I'm meeting the session players - and they're only the best in the business, these guys had worked with Elvis Presley and Marty Robins, I even had Garth Brook's personal string session players, I just cried." The trip to Nashville to cut his first album of ten original songs plus two from writers in Nashville was a dream come true for the 29-year-old singer songwriter whose talents are much bigger than his ego.

The first single "She Is Just To Hot For Me" is released on April 7th on Southbound Records, distributed by Grapevine / Polygram. Both songs on the single, "She Is Too Hot For Me" and "I Can't Take Any More" written by Sam.
